This event is held to raise money for students from around Georgia to be involved with summer missions throughout the world. Each summer, our BCM sends 20-25 students to serve in various parts of the United States and around the world through this vital program. The UGA BCM missions' goal for this year is to raise \$30,000. This bike ride will be one of the several fundraising events to help us accomplish our overall goal.

Bronze	\$50.00	(back of shirt, name only)

For inclusion on the shirts logo and payment must be to us by October 8th. Rider's and support team members will wear the shirt during the three-day event. Sponsorships of \$150 or above receive a complementary t-shirt.

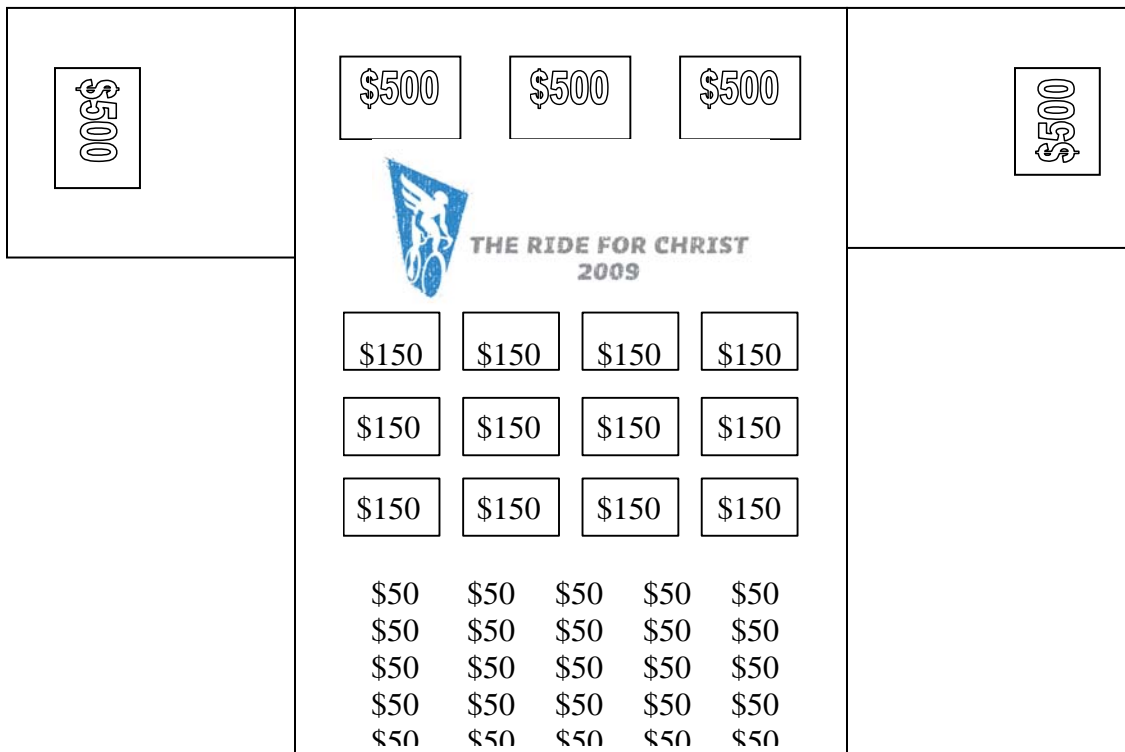
We accept donations of cash or in-kind (goods and services). Different types of donations can be combined to reach various sponsorship levels. Any donation would be greatly appreciated.

Types of Donations:
